

Red Bank, Tennessee Public Parks and Green Spaces

Old Red Bank Middle School Property (11.97 acres) Home of the future Red Bank Central Park 3715 Dayton Boulevard

This open, gently sloped green space in the city's center – at the corner of West Leawood Avenue and Dayton Boulevard – is the former site of the Red Bank Middle School, and of the Red Bank High School before that. Except for the old stone walls and staircases, all the old buildings, facilities and infrastructure have been removed.



This future public park is by far the largest open, mostly-level public green space in Red Bank, being 6 times larger than the next-biggest such level open space, at White Oak Park.



The land behind this scenic stone wall and its welcoming historic stone staircase is owned by the City of Red Bank, and is enjoyed by citizens for walkable relaxation and informal recreation.
