Honorable Mayor Jeno:

Recreation Educational Services recently received notification from the National Park Service; Southeast Region, in reference to the 1970 LWCF and 2011 Conversion of roughly 14.6 acres from Morrison Springs Park.

In review of the 2011 LWCF Conversion, NPS found Red Bank to be in non-compliance and has rescinded the conversion. The letter to RES from NPS detailing their findings is accompanying this correspondence. Red Bank will need to conduct a new conversion and replace the 14.6 acres taken out of inventory from Morrison Springs Park. The replacement property will need to be developed within 3 years of receiving the conversion approval from NPS.
